November 7, 2023 General Election

Oct 10: Voter registration closes

Oct 11: Opening of Early In-Person and Vote-by-Mail (Absentee) voting.
Check the Board of Elections website for hours (*see below*)

Oct 31, 8:30 pm: Deadline for applications by mail for a Vote-by-Mail/Absentee ballot to be mailed.

Nov 5: Voting in-person at the Board of Elections ends at 5:00 pm

Nov 6: All Vote-by-Mail/Absentee ballots mailed anywhere in the U.S. must be postmarked on or before this date and received at the Board of Elections on or before Nov 11 to be counted.

Nov 7, 6:30 am-7:30 pm: Election Day - Provisional voting at the Board of Elections

Nov 7: All Vote-by-Mail / Absentee ballots returned in person must be received at the Board of Elections by 7:30 pm to be counted.
